Come in, it's open!

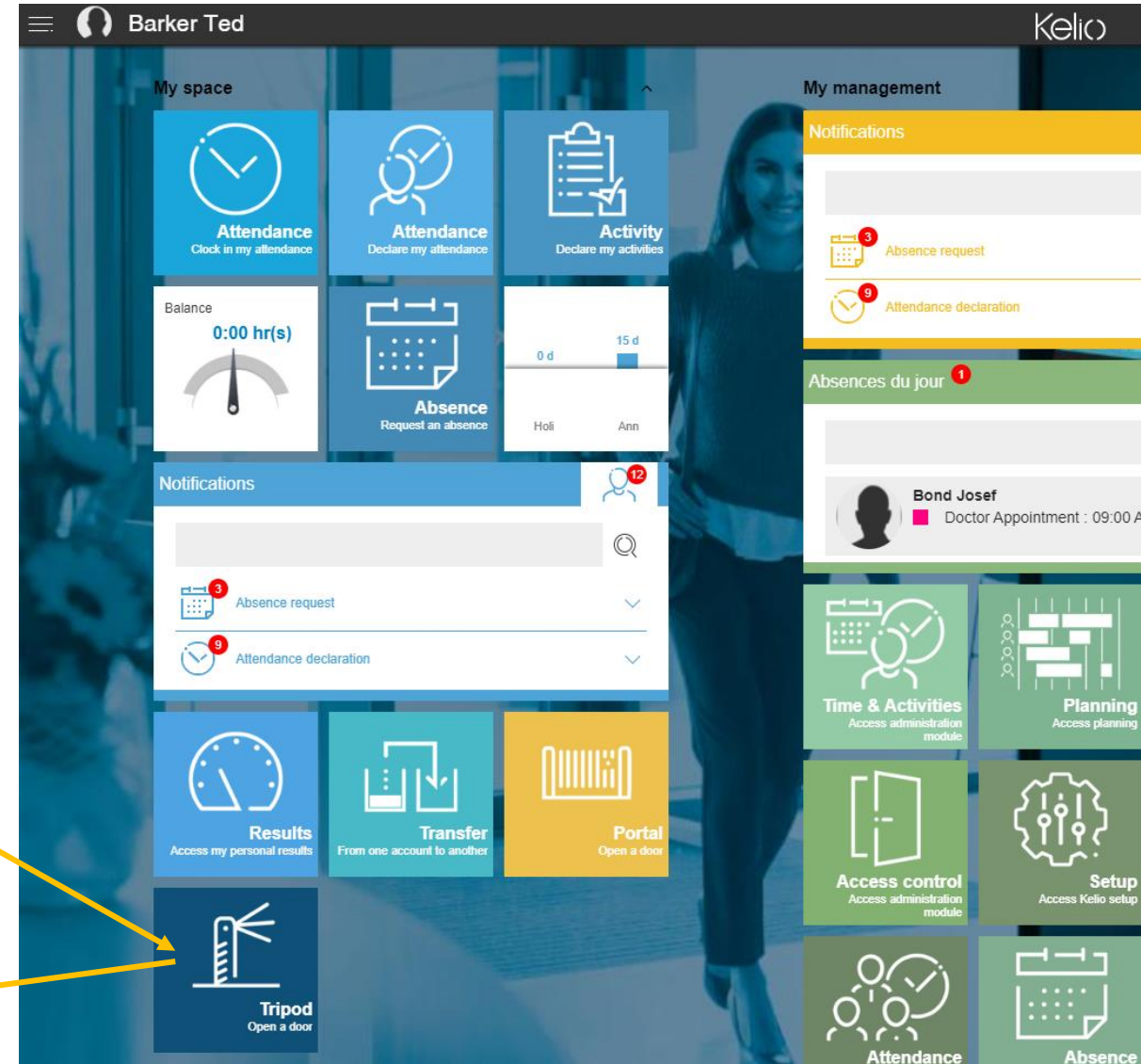
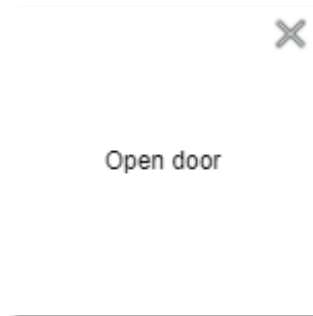
Application on the Kelio portal

The *Door opening* tile is now on your Kelio portal. Easily unlock an access point for on-call duty or use a telephone as a remote control: There are a variety of uses that allow you to simplify access opening while maintaining the security and traceability of your system.

Choosing the access point

There are several configuration options:

- The same number of tiles as access points = Remote control mode (you click and the door opens)
- One tile for all access points (you click and choose the required access point from a list)





Configure it the way you like!

The *Door opening* feature can be launched via a tile on a computer or touchscreen device or via the navigation menu.

The configurable elements in the tile are:

- Access point lists
- Opening duration
- Reason for opening
- Opening comment
- People concerned



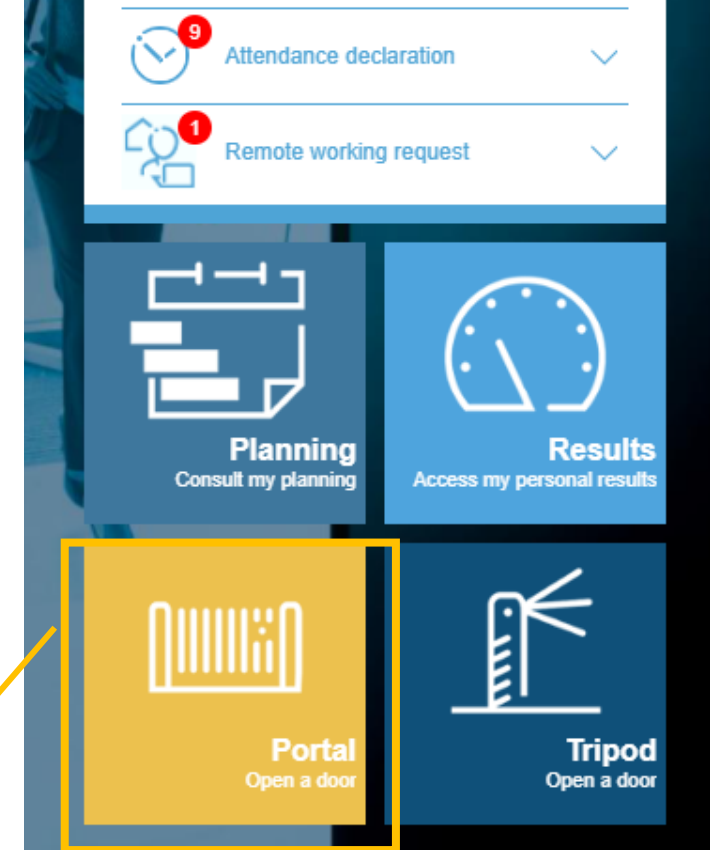
An advance setup is available for persons authorised to enter your premises in order to enhance your security:

- Anonymous crossing: useful for delivery people, for example
- The user connected to the application: to use the application in remote control mode
- A selection of employees: to unlock access points with more traceability
- A selection of visitors: the list can be filtered (to come/in progress/waiting/terminated and not taken place within the last 24 hours/terminated and taken place within the last 24 hours
- The crossing of several people per opening can be authorised

IMPORT VISITORS AND VISITS

Kelio's visitor management module can be used to plan and register the visitor on a reception terminal. This allows you to digitalise the reception, circulate safety instructions, set up a questionnaire and sign right at the terminal. During a fire drill, visitors are included when accounting for people present.

However, certain organisations already have a visitor registration tool or use their messaging. You can now develop an interface using our visitor and visit import webservices to interface your solution with ours and benefit from the use of our reception terminal.
